



Teachers of Physics, Mathematics and Philology faculty of Urgench State University are taking part in the training. Training courses will begin on July 18, 2018 and continue for 12 days at the Faculty of Philology and Computer Technology of Coruña University until July 3. The courses are organized on the Moodle platform at an average of 4.5 hours a day and 3.5 hours on the basis of "blended learning" technology.


